What is a Floorcloth?

Floorcloths are constructed from a heavy weight cotton canvas, hand painted with acrylic paints, hand finished and completely sealed for protection and long lasting wear.

Workshop Details

During this hands-on workshop you will learn how to make a floorcloth from beginning to end, and leave with a small floorcloth of your own design. Because of drying times your floorcloth will not be 100% complete, but you will leave with the materials and skills to complete it.

We will make a floorcloth approximately placemat size.

What to Bring

If you have a simple design in mind for a small rectangular floorcloth, bring that. Design ideas will be available. Please bring the following tools if you have them available:

- Yardstick or long ruler
- Scissors
- Small paintbrushes for painting the design
