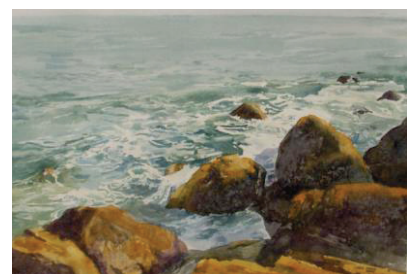
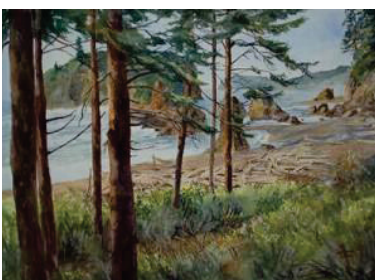

Your Art Show is coming!

The Member's Show and Sale is November 4th through the 7th. The Artist and Guest Reception will be on November 3rd from 6 p.m. - 7:30 p.m.

I hope that you are all getting your work framed or ready for this show. We are all making lovely plans and have great hopes of wonderful success for you, but it all hinges on your participation and involvement. You are needed, without you there is no Sequim Arts.

Please remember that we are in need of donations of following items for the Silent Auction (needed by Oct. 28th meeting or ASAP), food for the reception - see Pat Oden, Docents to work at the show - see Cynthia Thomas and helpers in lots of different areas. Your final chance to sign up to assist will be the October 28th meeting of Sequim Arts.

October 28th is also your final date to pre-enter the show. This is a new feature and we are asking you to send in or hand deliver your form with your entry fee before that date so we can keep the redundancy down to a minimum. Last year when we put up the lovely little cards for your work, 3 of us walked all over that room dozens of times to try and find each piece and post the card. I am sure that you wouldn't want to do it anymore than I do, especially when it can be avoided by just pre-entering. With a pre-entered piece we can print the cards in advance and the hanging crew can post them at that time.

We decided that a pre-entered piece would also get precedence in the hanging process. We now have over 150 members, if each person were to enter 3 pieces in the show, that would amount to 450 pieces. We nearly ran out of room last year so it is possible we may have to turn your entries away if you do not pre-enter. Last year we used nearly every last space we had, and only we had 187 entries that time. There may be not be room if you just bring in your entries with your payment on receiving day, which is Tuesday, November 2nd from 9a.m. - 2p.m. at Saint Luke's, although we will make every effort to hang or show every piece we can fit into the room.

This show is open to all members of Sequim Arts in good standing. Each member may enter three (3) pieces that have never previously been entered in the Member's Show and created no more than two years ago.

ENTRY FEES:
A fee of \$5 will be charged for each piece entered.

CONDITIONS:

- All media will be accepted, including but not limited to:
Two-dimensional works: watercolor, oil, acrylic, pencil, pen and ink, pastel, collage, mixed media, photography;
Three dimensional works: assemblage, sculpture (any medium), basketry, ceramics, glass, jewelry, and fine art textiles.
- Maximum dimension (including frame) not to exceed 44 inches.
- Two-dimensional work must be dry, properly framed and wired for hanging with screw eyes and wire (no saw tooth hangers).
- Class work is acceptable; however if it is a copy of someone else's original work, it must be labeled as a copy and may not be for sale.
- Sequim Arts reserves the right to reject any entry deemed inappropriate.

RECEIVING:
Tuesday, November 2 from 9 am to 2 pm at St. Luke's Parish Hall.

RELEASE:
Sunday, November 7 at 4:30 pm, NOT BEFORE. Claim checks will be required. Members are asked to pick up their work as soon after 4:30 pm as possible. *Items not picked up by 5:30 pm will be charged a \$20 per day storage fee.*

SALES:
A 25% commission will be charged on all sales. *We suggest that participating members consider pricing their work for sale, if possible.*

Fill out the Entry Labels (below), cutout entry labels and attach a completed entry label to the back top left hand corner of 2D work, and on a visible place of 3D work.
