Here it comes again! The Sequim Arts Student Art Show for Clallam County students in grades 6-12 is just around the corner. Please encourage all of your students to participate in this year's show.

This year the **17th Annual Student Art Show** has been moved up to the month of **February** at the Sequim Museum and Arts Center, 175 W. Cedar, Sequim. The show will run **February 4-26, 2011**. This means entries will be due **Friday, January 28th & Saturday, January 29th**. An **Artist's Reception** will be held on **Friday, February 4th from 5-8pm**. Cash prizes and certificates will be awarded at 6pm. We invite all student artists, their families, friends and teachers to join us in recognizing the students' talents at this reception. Friday, February 4th is also Sequim's monthly 1st Friday Art Walk from 5-8pm.

The Olympic Peninsula Audubon Society will give awards again for **bird themed art**. Winning art work will be displayed during Bird Fest at the River Center in April.

In addition, please be thinking about a High School student to nominate for our **2 Emerging Artist Awards**. Candidates should be creative and hard-working, but maybe haven't been recognized or have faced challenges in their HS years. It is our hope that an award such as this would give them the confidence and encouragement they could use to spread their artistic wings and fly!
